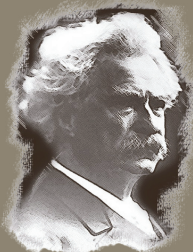

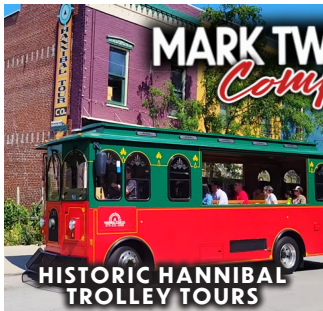

“Take a Step Back in Time” On the National Register of Historic Places.

Take a guided tour of a turn-of-the-century Gilded Age Mansion and see the Main Hall where Mark Twain addressed 300 of Hannibal Society from the Grand Staircase during his last visit to Hannibal in June of 1902. Rockcliffe Mansion is a grand residence originally built on 10 acres, situated on a large limestone bluff, with spectacular views, overlooking the Mississippi River and the town of Hannibal. The home was built between 1898 and 1900 by lumber baron, John J. Cruikshank, Jr., for his wife and four daughters. Rich in architectural detail, and decorated in a late Victorian style, most of the original antique furnishings, hardware, lighting, plumbing fixtures and clothing from the Cruikshank family are preserved and on display. After being abandoned for 43 years, and just days before demolition, the mansion’s 30 rooms were saved, and are now open to the public for guided tours.

Margaret Tobin "Molly" Brown was born and raised in Hannibal, in a humble cottage that you can visit to this day.

From an early age, Brown learned the value of hard work. After finishing her education at age 13, she went to work in the Garth Tobacco Company in Hannibal.

According to family lore, Brown's father, John Tobin, was a steadfast abolitionist – determined to end slavery and always treat people equally. His daughter learned her lifelong values of helping others during her childhood years.

Brown is perhaps best known for saving many lives through her quick thinking, leadership skills, and heroic response when the Titanic sank in 1912.

She helped people affected by World War I, setting up a relief station for soldiers. Brown was later awarded the French Legion of Honor for her valor. She also tirelessly advocated for women's rights and was the first woman to run for the U.S. State Senate in 1914.

Come and see why Molly Brown was truly "Unsinkable" by visiting the Molly Brown Birthplace and Museum, located at 400 N. Main Street in Hannibal. Her story is remarkable, and it all started right here in Hannibal!
